

LANCELIN PRIMARY SCHOOL

CURRICULUM, ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING POLICY

Rationale:

To ensure that the staff of Lancelin Primary School are implementing a curriculum to meet the needs of all students, from Kindergarten to Year 6, and assesses and reports student achievement in accordance with the established standards of the School Curriculum and Standards Authority.

Policy Guidelines:

Principals, in consultation with teaching staff, must develop school based assessment and reporting plans that:

- Comply with the requirements of the School Curriculum and Standards Authority;
- Assess and report achievement of each student from Kindergarten to Year 6 at the end of each semester; and
- Comply with the Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Procedures.

Responsibility for Implementation and Compliance:

- Implementation of the policy is the responsibility of principals and teaching staff.
- Compliance monitoring is the responsibility of line managers

How does this look at Lancelin Primary School:

- Semester 1 (term 2) and Semester 2 (term 4) Reporting to Parents to be completed each year in accordance with DoE reporting to parents expectations
- Open Classroom afternoon early term 1 to meet the parents, and see the classrooms.
- Term 2 Parrent Teacher interview day. # way interview to discuss progress
- SAER/ individual student meetings conducted with parents throughout the year as required.
