DRESS CODE POLICY

Lancelin Primary School, in consultation with the School Board has developed a dress code that requires all children who attend LPS to be wearing the school uniform.

We believe the wearing of school uniform:

- Promotes identity and pride
- Encourages equity amongst students
- Prevents bullying on the basis of clothing brands
- Ensure the students appearance reflects the expectation of the School community.
- Enhances the profile of the school
- Strengthens belonging to the school
- Enhances group safety where applicable
- Allows for individual expression through alternatives provided
- Allows for modification due to medical or cultural practices.

The dress code is as follows:

Summer

School logo polo shirt

Navy skorts

Navy shorts

Broad Brimmed School faction hat

Sneakers or covered shoes

Winter

School logo polo shirt

School logo hoodie

School logo zippered jacket

Navy track pants/ shorts/leggings

Footwear

Shoes, sneakers, covered shoes are acceptable footwear.

Jewellery

Jewellery is discouraged at school due to a safety issue it may present, and students will be asked to remove jewellery that could pose a risk of injury.

Jewellery should be limited to a watch, sleepers or studs.

No wearing of body jewellery of any kind

Excursions

Full school uniform should be worn for excursions, for ease of identification.

Cultural groups

Head dress of the Muslim community is recognised as school uniform (blue white or black preferred)

Hair

Long hair should be tied back, secured away from eyes.

Students not following dress code may be denied the opportunity to represent the school at official activities and functions, which may include choir, excursions, sporting and social events.
