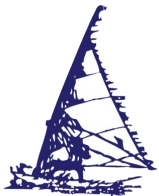

PJ DAY

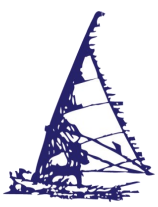

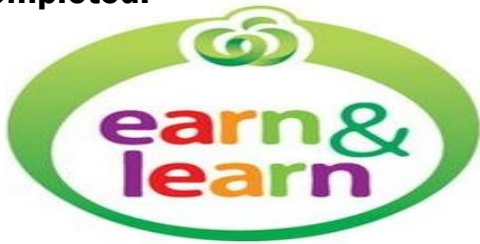
