Well we have certainly been thrown into winter over the past few days. Great to see the hoodies getting another good wearing! It really has been quite a chilly start to the days!

NEW LOGO HOODIES

ZONES OF REGULATION

As part of our School Development Day last Monday, we spoke as a staff about introducing Zones of Regulation as part of our Behaviour Engagement System. As the vast majority of our students do the right thing both in and out of the classroom at all times we felt that it was important that we focused on the positive interactions between students, and the building of resilience when things don't go our way. Included in this newsletter is an example of the chart that some students have in their class (this is more aimed towards junior primary) but across the school the message is the same. You may wish to have this displayed on the fridge at home as it helps remind the children about the zones. At school we are teaching our classes how to choose strategies to help them get back to green, for example, closing you eyes and take a big breath, or counting backwards from ten. Each child has their own "toolbox" that they have made in which they have a personal list of the strategies they use in each zone to get back to green. We have already found this has resinated with the children because, as we are so fortunate to have very little negative behaviour at Lancelin Primary, we are able to support our students with resilience strategies they can adopt when sometimes "life gives them lemons!" As this is a new initiative, which has been facilitated by Kirrily Skoglund and Kim Simpson, we will keep you up to date with any new information through future newsletters, or you are welcome to chat with any of the staff as we are all excited about how this will positively impact our school, and would be happy to share info about the programme with you.
