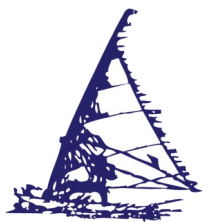

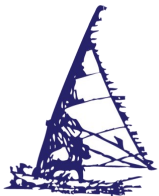

## END OF YEAR PRESENTATION NIGHT

The classes are really working hard on the performance of "A Starry Night". This is an adaptation of Aladdin, which has been rewritten by Ms Campbell.

The night will begin **promptly at 5pm**. The formal part of the evening will consist of the award presentations for each class as well as subject specific and community awards. Once this has concluded there will be a short intermission and then the performance will commence. ## CHARGES, CONTRIBUTIONS AND BOOK LISTS

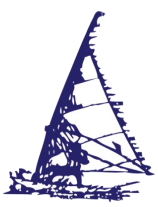
